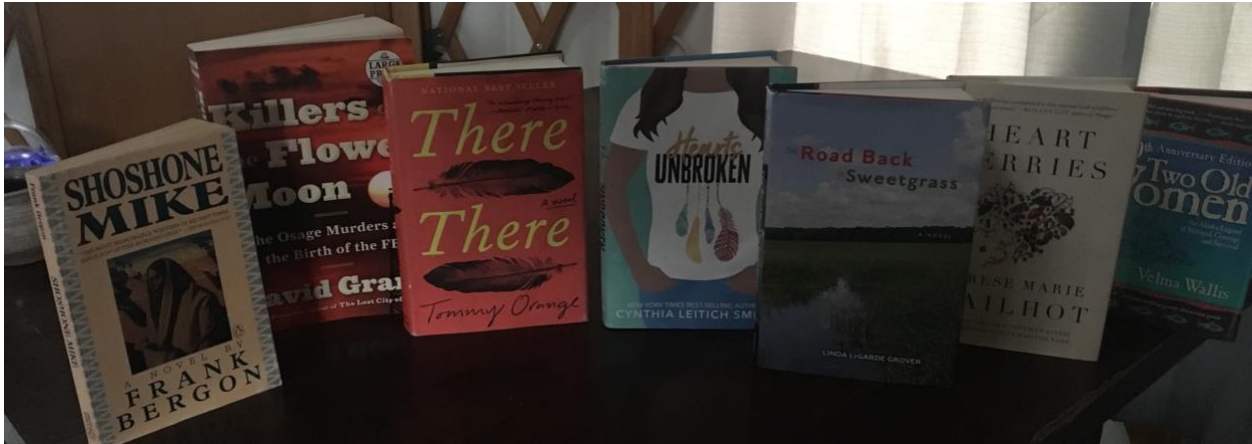


Native Community Reads Booklist 2021
