What to bring:

WEATHER

Temperature in Ruby Valley, Nevada in the early fall averages 62 degrees F during the day and about 36 degrees F during the night. Bring warm clothing and blankets if you are staying the night!

LOCATION

The gathering is located on the Moon Ranch in Ruby Valley, NV. It is approximately 52 miles southeast of Elko, NV. Take Exit 321, proceed on State Route 229, which merges to State Route 767. Follow the red, blue, white and green flags to the Moon Ranch (the road to the Moon Ranch is to the left of Neff Equipment). We will have markers/signs at the turnoff.
